# WELCOME TO THE LNG BUNKERING **SUMMIT 2025 NORTH AMERICA**

Dear Colleagues,

This year has seen profound policy change, from the removal of regulatory barriers that restricted shipto- ship LNG transfers, to a renewed push for USbuilt vessels under the 'SHIPS for America' initiative. The clear shift prioritises domestic capability and commercial opportunity - but what does this mean for our industry?

LNG is being framed not just as a clean fuel, but as a strategic fuel investment; one which could bring both momentum for those investing, but also complexity for the future of the energy landscape in North America versus the rest of the world.

At the same time, international pressure is changing with the outcomes of the IMO's MEPC 83 meeting earlier this year, and those to come this October. There is a push for shipowners worldwide to re-evaluate their energy and compliance strategies. For globally operating fleets, and those who need to align with customer sustainability goals, international standards remain non-negotiable. Our summit will bring those across the value chain together to understand how to move forward following regulatory changes, and ensure long-term strategies align.

The LNG Bunkering Summit North America comes at a critical moment for this discussion. With fuel strategies increasingly driven by economics, the LNG pathway offers short-term compliance and cost advantages, but long-term discussions on the viability of this pathway must also be discussed.

From infrastructure gaps, to the slow rollout of new US bunker vessels - and the role of LBM in that pathway – the summit is the hub to understand what is happening behind the scenes of official announcements.

We are proud to bring together stakeholders from across the LNG value chain, policy influencers, port authorities and shipowners at a pivotal time for the market. We remain the only North American platform designed to understand how compliance and commercial opportunity will be balanced as part of a broader approach to future marine fuel procurement – and to explore how our industry can work to fix the gaps in supply and demand.

We look forward to welcoming you to Virginia Beach this year.

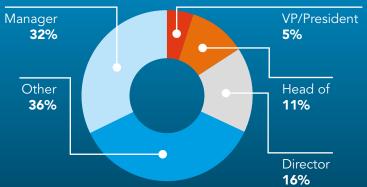
