University of Maine System

- Established in 1968, Maine's largest educational enterprise
- The University of Maine System features <u>seven</u> <u>universities</u> - some with multiple campuses located across the state, as well as eight University College outreach centers, a law school, an additional 31 course sites, and Cooperative Extension
- Annual enrollment of nearly 30,000 students and serves over 500,000 individuals annually through educational and cultural offerings

University of Maine System: March 2013

Administrative Review Findings:

- Procurement activity/staff fragmented across seven universities
- Procurement policies applied inconsistently
- Manual / paper based systems (Travel, Pcard)
- eCatalog underutilized
- "Buyer" versus "Sourcing" procurement process
- \$140mm potentially addressable spend
- 100,000 invoices annually, manual processes, late payments common

University of Maine System: April 2017

Strategic Procurement Shared Services

- Unified campus-based Strategic Procurement Department with new job descriptions
- Strategic Sourcing Unit in place
- FY 14-16:
 - \$4mm validated savings from Sourcing activity
 - \$1mm salary savings
- \$1mm infrastructure investment
 - Travel Expense management System
 - Automated invoice processing
 - Training, communication, support structure
- FY15, FY 16: NPI Procurement Excellence Award

University of Maine System: Accounts Payable

- Invoice processing workflow reporting
- Digital Mail Room: invoice scanning /dual data entry
- Payment Mechanisms:
